Therapeutic SCUBA diving is an activity that

helps patients improve cardiovascular strength, emotional wellbeing, mobility,

When diving, nitrogen levels change to help with cognitive disorders.

This rehabilitative activity has produced positive results for years. Wounded Warriors experience reduced pain and a liberation not found on land.

♥ Back in the Saddle Warriors® (BITS Warriors) Equine Therapeutic Riding and Hippotherapy

Horses and humans have a pelvis that moves in the same three-dimensional way. Hip movement is

identical when walking. When a person sits on a moving horse, muscle groups for normal human movement are strengthened.

Equine Therapeutic Riding for children with special needs/disabilities of wounded Warriors.

♥ K9 Healing Warriors

program will train both the Warrior and the dog to meet the individual needs of the Warrior.
